About the Scholarship

The purpose of the HRCC Scholarship is to promote and encourage the academic achievement and preparation for the practice of Human Resources and help students financially attain the highest level of education possible. One or more scholarships of \$1000 will be awarded during the Spring of 2018 and again in the Fall of 2018.

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Applicants must:

- Be a student studying in an accredited program with a concentration in Human Resources at the undergraduate or graduate level, or enrolled in a certificate program affiliated with an academic institution
- Have a minimum 3.0 GPA in your major, with a minimum, of 2.75 overall
- Have successfully completed 2 courses in Human Resources
- Be an HRCC member or be recommended by an HRCC member
- Prior HRCC scholarship recipients are not eligible
- Submittal of all documentation by May 25, 2018 for Spring timeline and October 26, 2018 for the Fall timeline.

To Apply

Applicants must submit:

- A signed, completed application form
- A cover letter describing academic accomplishments, work accomplishments, community activities, and career goals
- Copy of transcript
- A confidential letter from a supervisor or faculty member with whom the applicant has completed one course
- Non-HRCC member applicants must include a confidential letter of recommendation from an HRCC member describing the applicant's qualities and contributions related to the human resource field in pursuit of their degree
- Answer the following questions in essay form. Please limit your answers to no more than 100 words each:
 - How would this scholarship benefit you?
 - A specific example that describes your leadership abilities
 - Explain your reasons for pursuing a career in the field of Human Resources
 - What are your plans after you complete your college education?
 - Today's HR professional is challenged with constant changes due to a changing economic climate. What are three areas that an HR professional needs to be proficient in order to be successful?
